Dear Producer:

Enclosed is a 13-month supply of charts for your use. These charts are to be used only on Gatherco stations and not producer deduct meters. At this time, you should have an ample supply of charts to carry you through to our next mailing. Therefore, if you do request additional charts prior to that time, you will be invoiced accordingly.

You will be responsible for purchasing your own envelopes and applying the proper postage as required when mailing your charts to Gatherco on a monthly basis, per the chart changing instructions below. When purchasing your envelopes, please use a 9" x 12" manila envelope. All charts are to be mailed to the following address:

All charts should be mailed within two days after the final change dates as listed below for all systems. Charts received late will not be processed until the following month resulting in delayed payment. Please make sure that the charts are submitted with all of the proper information completed on the back of the chart **including the 6-digit meter number.**

The chart-changing schedule is as follows (**All systems except Elk**):

We would like to thank you for your continued support and inform you that Gatherco is committed to reducing retainage and continues to invest in the maintenance and integrity of its gathering systems. Our operations include pipeline repairs and replacement, line patrols to locate and repair leaks, daily monitoring of pipeline pressure and compressor operations, meter testing, and the installation of regulators as mentioned below. We believe our ongoing efforts and the continued investment in our system is mutually beneficial and we will continue to do such to improve and enhance our system. To assist our efforts in reducing retainage on our system, we also request that you immediately report any pipeline leaks that you may find, as well as any unusual changes in line pressure – either higher or lower. We appreciate your continued cooperation in these matters, as this allows Gatherco to respond more quickly to operational problems and will ultimately help lower the retainage on our system.

Gatherco is continuing its program of installing regulators as over-pressure protection in various systems to protect the integrity of the systems. This is necessary as many of the existing security valves/regulators are no longer reliable. The regulators will be adequately sized to handle the current volumes through the meters and will be set to restrict or shut off the flow at a higher line pressure, which would occur when a compressor station is down. You will need to make sure your production facilities are equipped with the proper equipment in the event the regulators become operational and shut off the flow of gas through the meters. Please remember that all compressors behind Gatherco meters need to be equipped with an operational high-pressure shutdown switch.

As a reminder, producers can retrieve their production data as well as historical gas price information from our website at www.gatherco.com. To retrieve your production data from our web site you will need to contact Bob Yackey at 330-682-7726 to obtain a PIN number. Once you have your PIN, you will need to access our website, then click on the “Producer Data” button on the home page and enter your PIN accordingly. You can also retrieve current and historical gas price information by clicking on the “Gas Pricing” link on the website.

Gatherco has contracted, at its own expense, to have meter inspections and prover tests performed, and anticipates that approximately 1/3 of the meters will be tested in the next three to four months. Gatherco will forward the test results to those producers, whose producer-owned meters do not test up to specifications. The producer must then determine if they want to make the required repairs, which would be at the producers’ expense. If you want to be present when your meters are being tested, please notify the Orrville office immediately.

Please note that the producers should not attempt to repair a meter or change the volume per revolution. Any meter that requires repairs or needs the volume per revolutions changed should be reported to the Orrville office. This procedure needs to be followed even if the producer owns the meter so that Gatherco can ensure that any equipment changes are reported to the chart integration company to ensure proper readings. Failure to follow these procedures will result in a delay in receiving credit for accurate production volumes.
